Volunteer Release and Waiver of Liability Form (“Release”)

Whereas, “Volunteer” shall mean the adult identified herein who is 18 years of age or older and/or each person identified herein who is under the age of 18 for which the adult identified herein is the legal parent or guardian (“Parent/Guardian”), who is providing volunteer services and/or engaging in activities related to serving as a volunteer; and

Whereas, “Nonprofit” shall mean Fill Ministries, Inc., a nonprofit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia, including each of its directors, officers, employees, agents, successors and assigns.

1. Waiver and Release: Volunteer releases and forever discharges and holds harmless Nonprofit from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from the services provided to Nonprofit. Volunteer understands and acknowledges that this Release discharges Nonprofit from any liability or claim that Volunteer may have against Nonprofit with respect to bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, or property damage that may result from the services provided by Volunteer to Nonprofit or occurring while Volunteer is providing volunteer services.
2. Insurance: Volunteer understands that Nonprofit does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide Volunteer with financial or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health and disability benefits or insurance. Volunteer expressly waives any such claim for compensation or liability on the part of Nonprofit beyond what may be offered freely by Nonprofit in the event of injury or medical expenses incurred by Volunteer.
3. Medical Treatment: Volunteer hereby releases and forever discharges Nonprofit from any claim that may arise at any time as a result of any first-aid treatment or other medical services rendered in connection with an emergency in connection with providing volunteer services to Nonprofit.
4. Assumption of Risk: Volunteer understands that the services provided to Nonprofit may include activities that may be hazardous and inherently dangerous. Volunteer expressly assumes risk of injury or harm from these activities and releases Nonprofit from all liability.
5. Photographic Release: Volunteer grants and conveys to Nonprofit all rights, title, and interests in any and all photographs, images, video, or audio recordings of Volunteer or Volunteer’s likeness or voice made by Nonprofit in connection with providing volunteer services to Nonprofit.
6. Other: Volunteer expressly agrees that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Georgia and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Georgia. Volunteer agrees that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release is deemed invalid, the enforceability of the remaining provisions of this Release shall not be affected.
